What does this mean? We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.

How I hope and pray that we as a church will gather together and worship ... gladly hearing God's word ... not just because God says so... but because we want to.

If you haven't worshiped in church for a while, now is the time to renew that obligation and privilege.

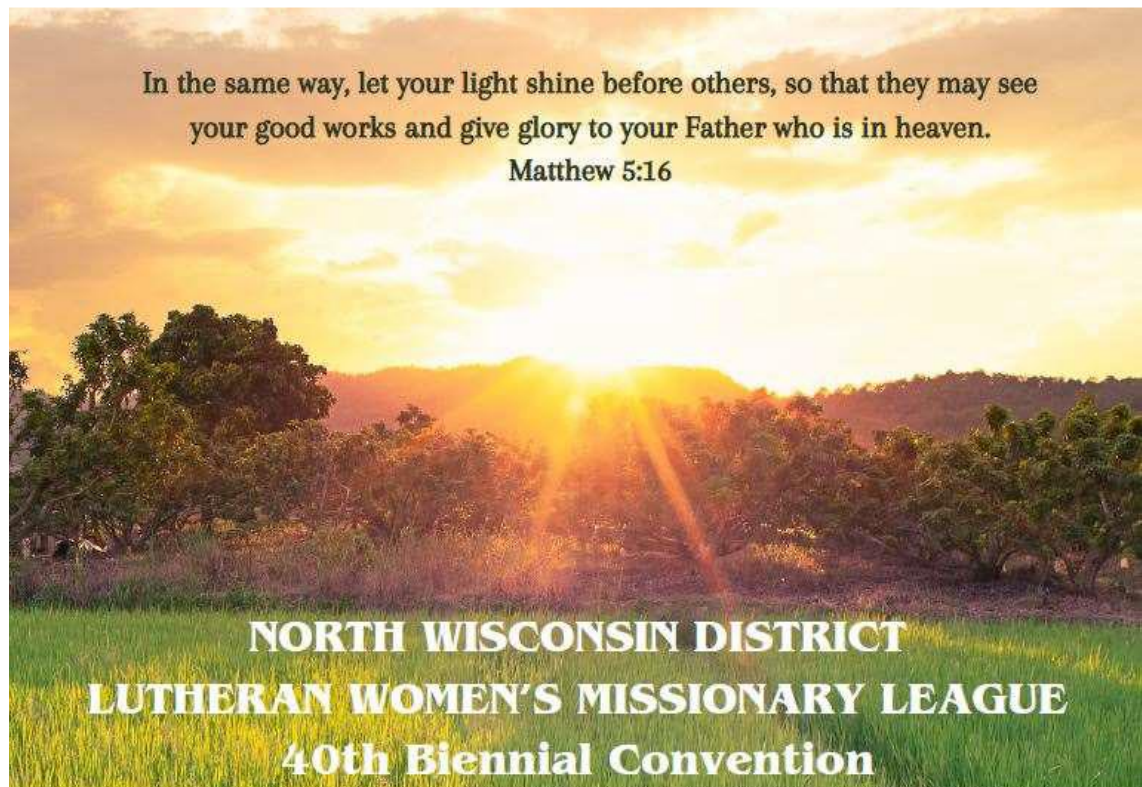
